By What/Who's Authority Is The Inspector General Appointed?

According to ARTICLE XIV Section 6 pg. 15 Dept. of Ohio CBL

The Department Commander, with the consent and approval of the SEC, shall appoint, at the Post-Convention SEC, a Chaplain, Historian, Public Relations Officer, ***Inspector General***, and such Committees as deemed necessary.

Duties of the Inspector General

*According to ARTICLE XV Duties of Officers Section
10 pg. 18 Dept. of Ohio CBL*

- The Department Inspector General shall be the investigating officer of the organization.
- By direction of the Department Commander or the SEC, the Department Inspector General shall make any necessary investigations pertaining to grievances, disciplinary cases, fraud or dishonesty within the organization and charges of conduct **unbecoming an AMVET** and,
- shall be empowered to have access to all records, financial and otherwise, of all: Districts, Posts, Post Officers or Members,
- when necessary, for the discharge of the Department Inspector General duties.

Duties of the Inspector General (cont.)

- ****When warranted the Inspector General has the authority to remove/suspend or place under Inspector General/Inspectors General TEAM, probation, of any AMVET Post, District/Post Officer or Post member during an investigation.****
- **In making such investigations, the Department Inspector General shall report the findings to the Department Commander, who shall, in turn, review the findings with: the Department Judge Advocate, and if warranted, report to the SEC., for adjudication.**
- **The Department Inspector General shall serve at the pleasure of the Department Commander and the SEC**

Who Appoints Deputy Inspectors General?

Article XIV Officers Section 6 pg. 15 Dept. of Ohio CBL

- The Department Commander, with the consent and approval of the SEC, shall appoint , up to two (2) **Deputy Inspectors General**, (vice Deputy Inspector Generals') from within each District.
- Starting in July, the Department Commander shall appoint up to, two (2) Deputy Inspectors General per District for a term of two (2) years.
- In the case of a vacancy in the position of Deputy Inspectors General for any reason, including the formation of a new District, the Department Commander shall appoint a Deputy Inspectors General to fill the unexpired term, or in the case of a new District, up to, two (2) Deputy Inspectors General for a two (2) year term.
- The Department Commander, with the consent of the SEC, may remove the Inspector General or any one of the Deputy Inspectors General.

Duties of the Deputy Inspectors General (Vice Deputy Inspector Generals')

- Deputy Inspectors General shall make any necessary investigations pertaining to grievances, disciplinary cases, fraud or dishonesty within the organization and charges of conduct **unbecoming an AMVET** and, shall be empowered to have access to all records, financial and otherwise, of all: Districts, Posts, Post Officers or Members.
- **When warranted the Deputy Inspectors General has the authority to suspend or place under Inspector General/Inspectors Generals' TEAM, probation, of any AMVET Post, District/Post Officer or Post member during an investigation.**

What Is The Inspector Generals Team?

- The Inspector Generals TEAM consists of all current Deputy Inspectors General, and can include but not limited to:

Past Department Commanders,
Past/current District Commanders,
Past/current Post Commanders, or Current
District Officers.

- Special Investigators can be appointed by the Department Inspector General/Department Commander and SEC.

Duties of the Inspector Generals' TEAM

- The Inspector General TEAM shall make any necessary investigations pertaining to grievances, disciplinary cases, fraud or dishonesty within the organization and charges of conduct **unbecoming an AMVET** and,
- shall be empowered to have access to all records, financial and otherwise, of all: Districts, Posts, Post Officers or Members, when necessary, for the discharge of the Department Inspector General/ the Inspector General TEAM duties.

Summary

- The Dept. Commander appoints the Inspector General.
- The I.G. is the investigative arm of the Dept.
- The I.G. has the authority to conduct investigations requested from the Dept. Cmdr. or SEC.
- The Dept. Cmdr. appoints Deputy I.G. and Special Investigators (with I.G., J.A. or SEC input*)
- The I.G. has the ability/authority with input* to form an I.G TEAM to assist with the Duties of the Dept. I.G.
- The Inspector Generals' Team can consist of Multiple Past/Current Dept., Dist. or Post Officers.
